## KING OF SAMURAI

Omihachiman is the place where Oda Nobunaga, a representative SAMURAI (warlord) of Japan's Warring States period, built the magnificent Azuchi Castle. With innovative tactics and political skills, he left many achievements and almost unified the country before his dream vanished. His legacy remains in this area.

Rental duration for items 1-② and 1-③ is up to 3 hours.

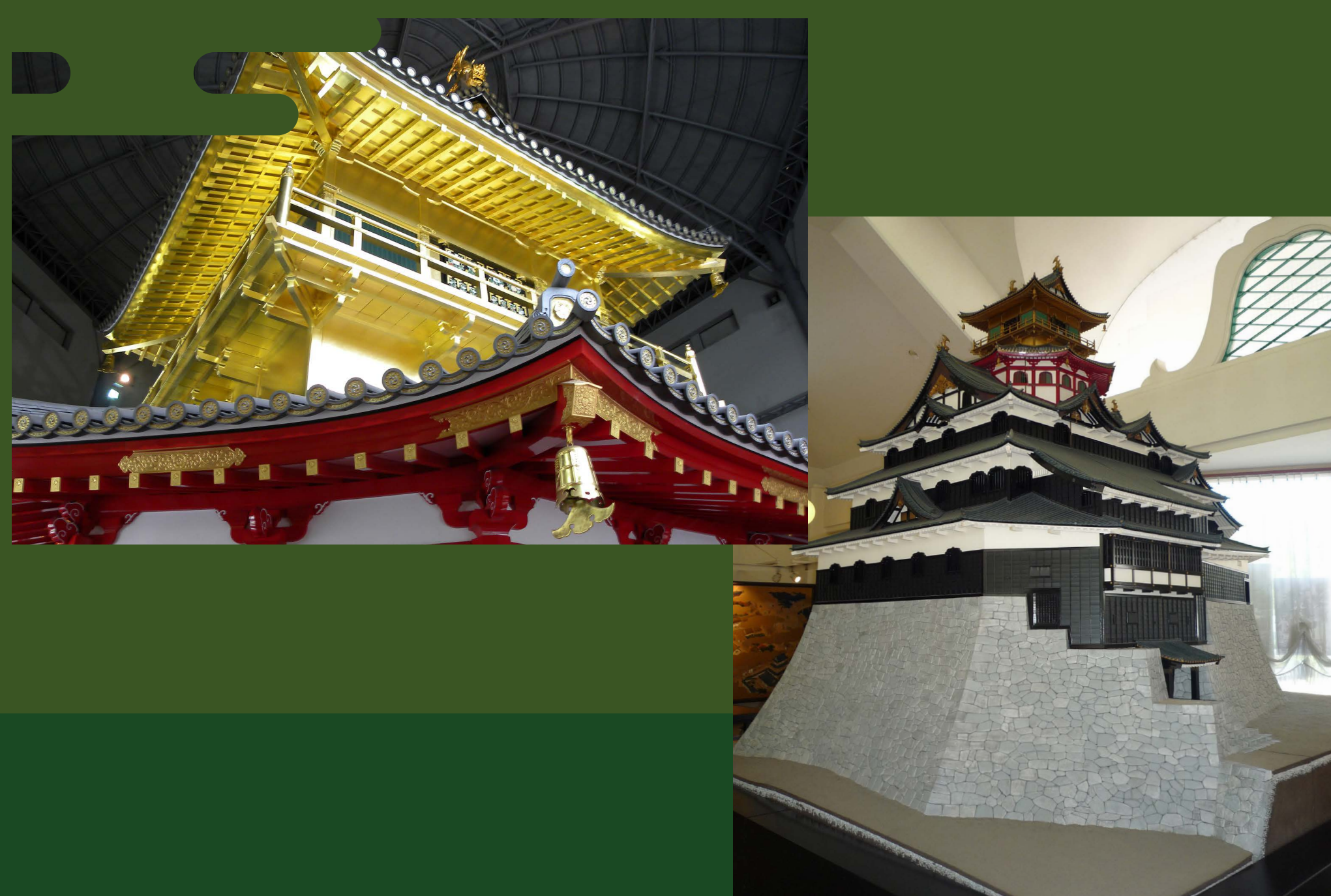
